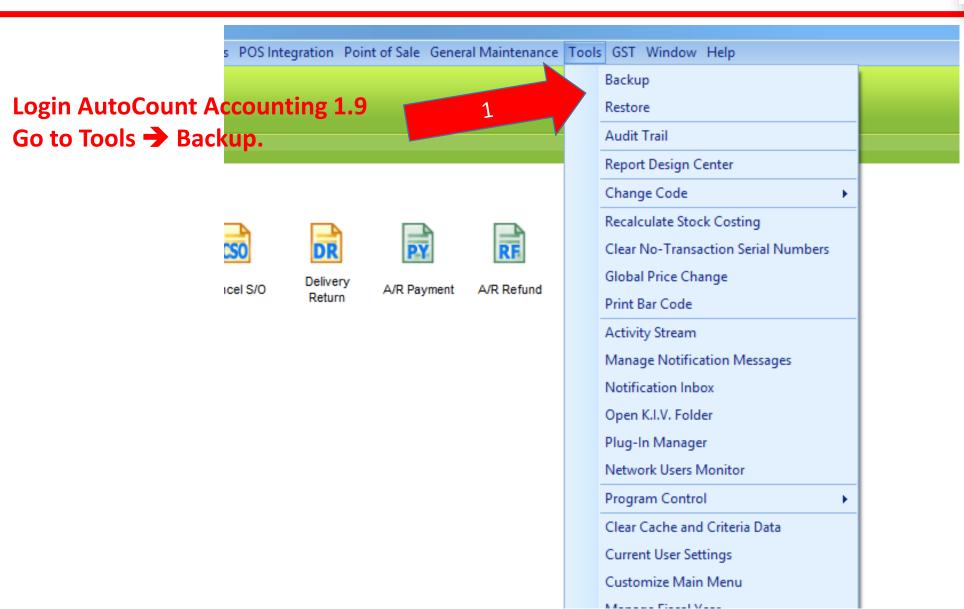


Backup Before Upgrade

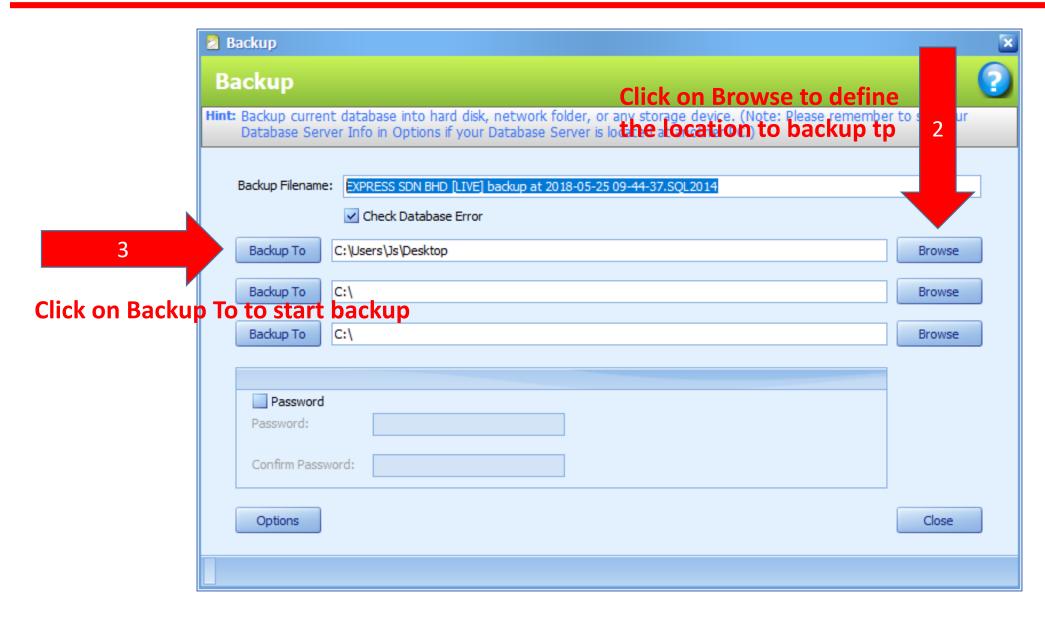


- We strongly recommend to perform a backup before upgrade.

- We strongly recommend to perform this action in Server PC.

- The following screenshots shows how to perform backup

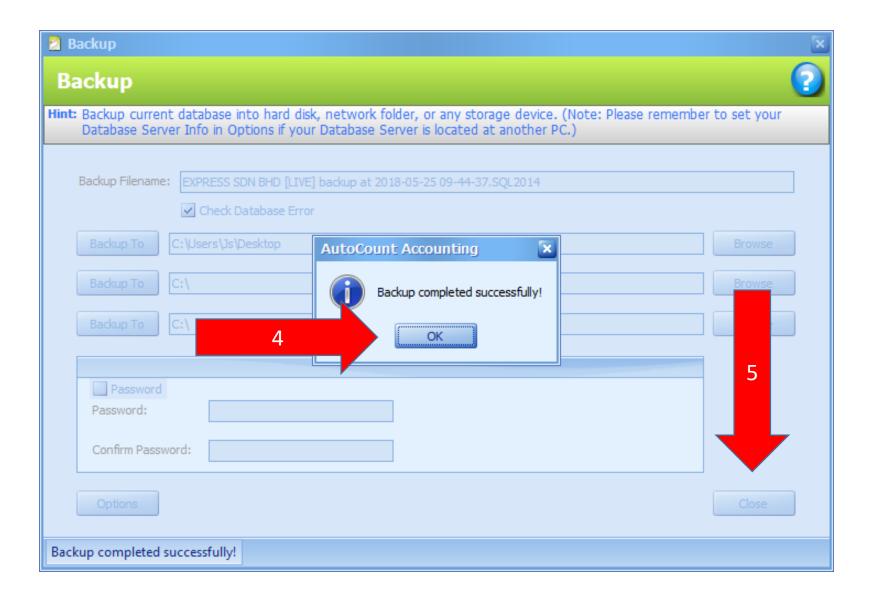














At Server PC

Please follow the following screenshots steps on how to upgrade.

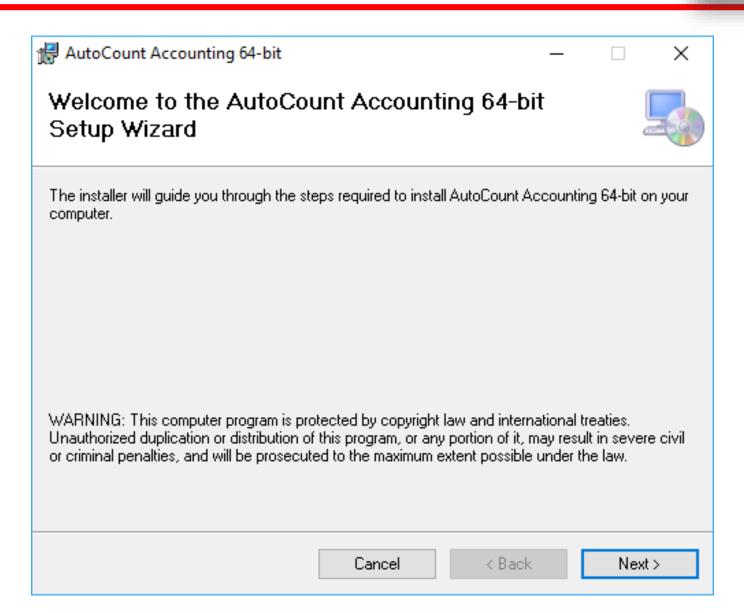


Step 1 Double Click to Run the downloaded installer



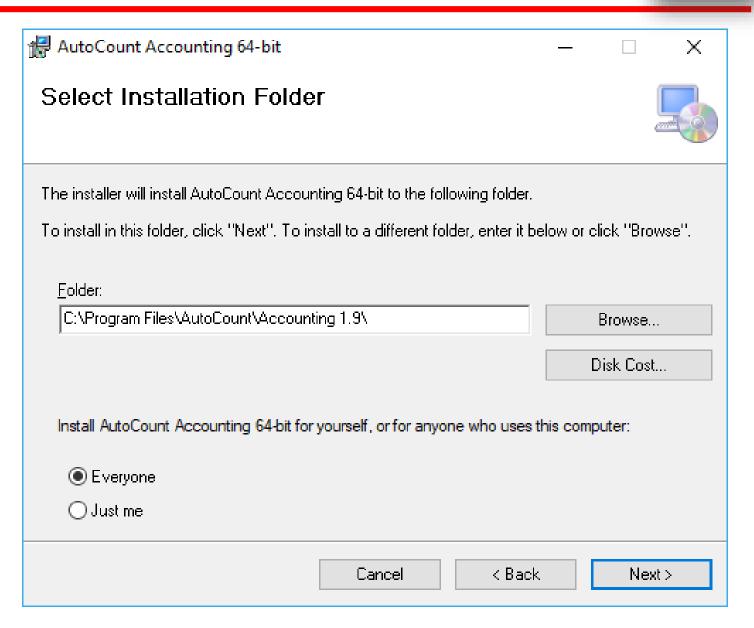


Step 2 you will be prompted a wizard, click Next



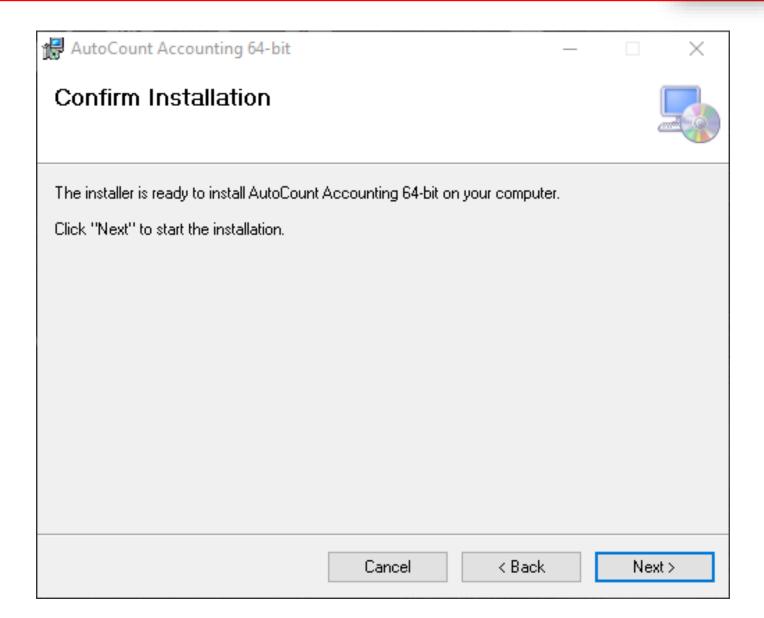


Step 3 choose your path, or just click Next





Step 4 confirm installation, click Next



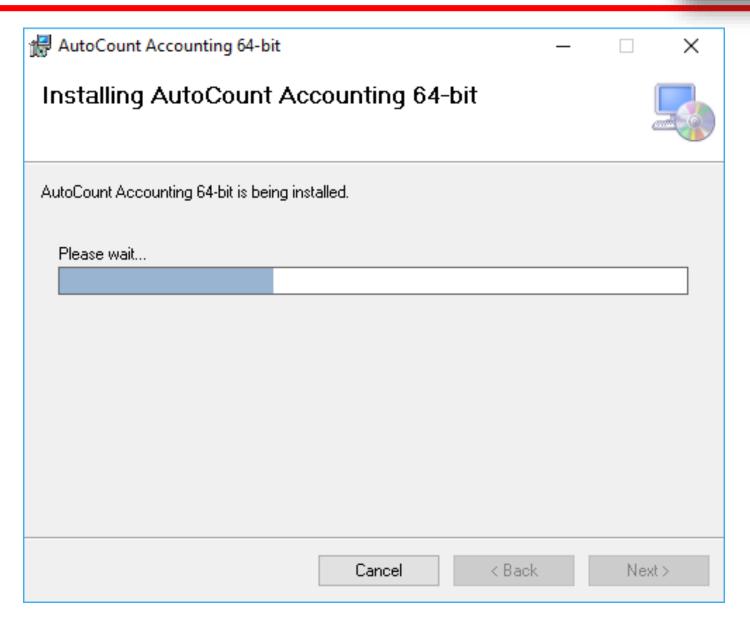


Step 5 License Agreement, tick "I Agree" and click Next



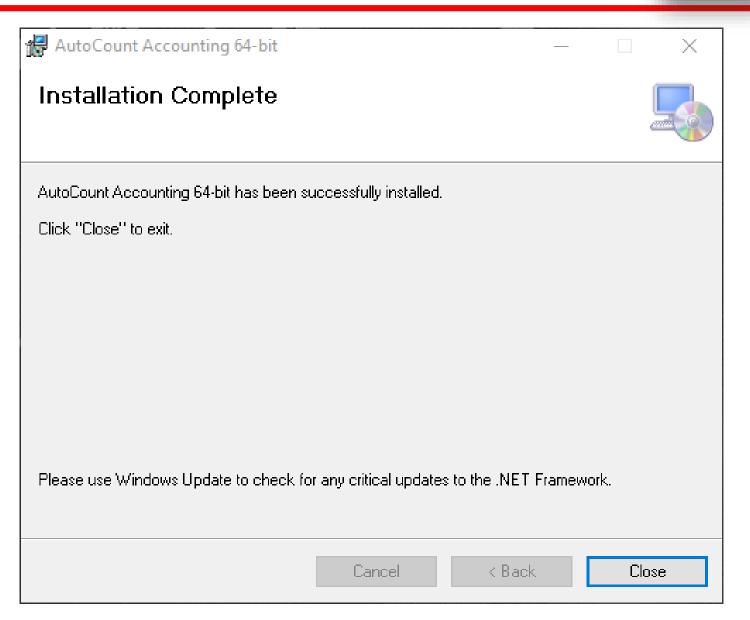


Step 6 Installation in progress, wait for it to finish



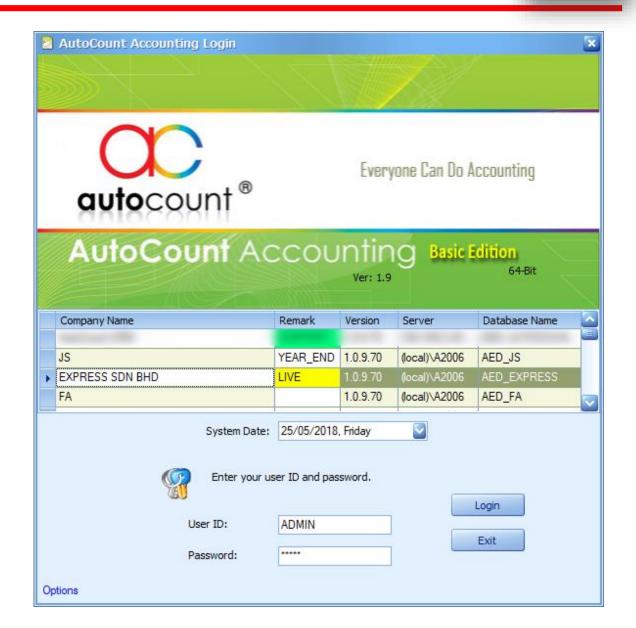


Step 7 once installation completed, click Close





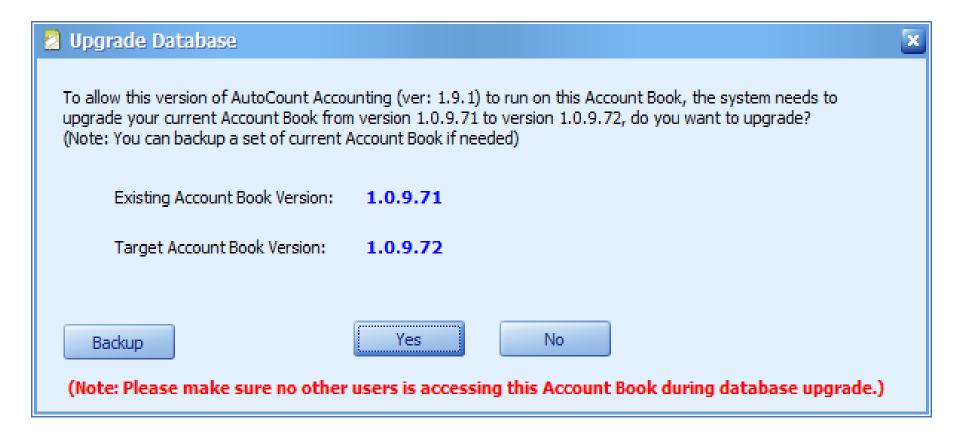
- A new icon will appear on your desktop –

- The usual AutoCount login screen will appear, login your Account Book





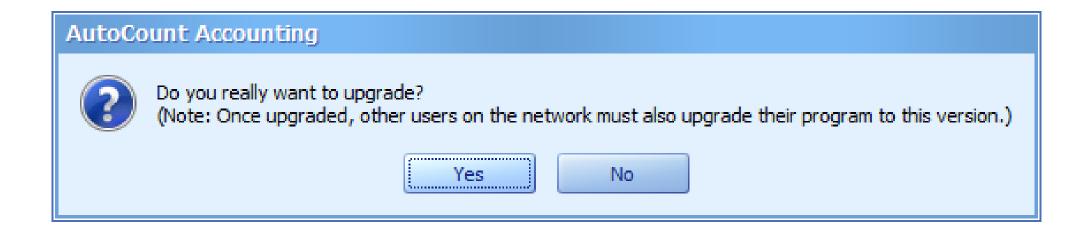
System will prompt a DB Upgrade screen, Click YES.

(Note: Please make sure there is no other user accessing this Account Book during database upgrade.)





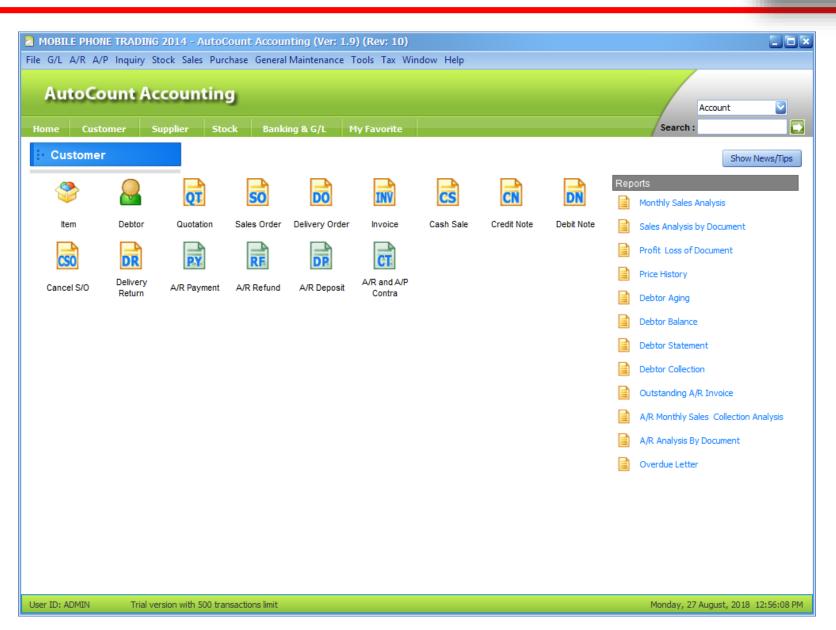
System will prompt a Confirmation to upgrade, click YES.
