

# Conducting the Missional Event

## **Purpose**

The goal of that meeting is share gospel with the people you talked in the last weeks in the context of group and experience what is meeting in a group.

That meeting is to help you to start work with a group on *Foundational Bible Studies* or *7 Stories of Hope*.

## **Location**

If that is possible the meeting shall take place in the home of *person of peace* from your circle of friends. Participants can be invited both by your friends and friends of *person of peace*. That could be people who you talked to doing your homework or people you just met or people from your *list of friends* that you did not have chance to talk yet.

## **Outcome**

The desired outcome is that participants would join *Foundational Bible Study* or *7 Stories of Hope*, which will start after that Missional Event. That shall help you start your new group.

## **Process**

The Missional Event is about 1 to 1.5 hours long. Because it is held in a home, 10-15 people are reasonable number of guests.

## **Suggested roles**

- Emcee and Discussion Facilitator
- My Story presenter
- Gospel presentation and prayer to receive Jesus
- Technical person

## Suggested Program

- Welcome guests :  
**Welcome, my name is .....**  
**I am very happy to see you today.**
- Introducing and thanking the host:  
**We want to thank ..... for inviting us to their home.**
- Explain the process of viewing an short film and discussing:  
**Our meeting will last about 1,5 hour and we are going to watch a few short films. After each of them there will be opportunity to share your experiences. Also ..... will share with us how God influenced his/her life.**
- Tell:  
**I invite you to watch short movie: *Freedom inside*.**
- After the film ask:  
**What did you liked the best? Why?**
- After the discussion say:  
**Thank you for sharing your thoughts. I invite you to watch another short film: *Cabernet*.**
- After the film ask:  
**What did you liked the best? Why?**
- After the discussion say:  
**What do you think, what these two short movies have in common with Christianity?**
- After the discussion say:  
**Thank you for sharing your thoughts. Before we will watch another film, I would like to invite here ..... to tell us how God changed his/her life.**
- Say:  
**Thank you ..... and I invite you for the next short film: My last day. That film shows the last hours of Jesus' live seen by the eyes of one of the men crucified together with Jesus.**
- After the film ask:  
**What did touch you the most? Why?**
- After the discussion say:  
**Thank you for sharing your thoughts.**
- Say:  
**Now I have a suggestion for us. I would like us to read two pages from these booklet as that is the very good summary of what we discussed today. Give the booklet to everybody. Say:  
**Let's open at the page 10. Read aloud pages 10 and 11 and ask questions, give them chance to answer. At the end allow these who are ready to receive Jesus do it by saying: Now I will read that prayer once again and if some of you would like to receive Jesus right now, please repeat the words of the prayer after me.****

- Say:  
**That is the end of our official part of our meeting. We would like to invite you for the similar meeting in two weeks, here in the same place.**

#### **After the meeting**

- Set a time within two days to meet with every person who was interested in spiritual things.
  - During that meeting go through the Four Spiritual Laws booklet, especially pages with circles and prayer.
  - Help them to create their list of friends and share Christ with their friends and family.
  - Invite them for the first meeting of *Foundational Bible Study* or *7 Stories of Hope*.
